

CALL FOR APPLI CATIONS - Short Term Consultancy

Background

The Global Coalition of TB Activists (GCTA) is a coalition of TB affected individuals bringing the lived experience of TB to the global platforms towards a people-centred rights-based response to TB. GCTA endeavours to bridge the gap between civil society organizations and other stakeholders, while ensuring that community is involved in all TB processes. Since its inception in October 2013, the GCTA has contributed significantly to the global and regional TB agenda through its network of activists, achieving a number of significant milestones along the way. GCTA seeks applications from interested and eligible individuals to provide GCTA with a SWOT analysis of options for registration/ hosted options.

Scope of Work

- 1. Compiling a list of global organizations that may be open to hosting a TB community organisation.
- 2. Review and consultations with selected organizations
- 3. Analysis of the review and pros and cons of each option.
- 4. Report identifying the top 3 feasible host organizations or registration opportunities best suited for GCTA with rationale.

The consultant will work closely with the GCTA Secretariat team. The work shall be executed under the direct supervision of the CEO.

Eligibility Criteria

Experience of having been part of Global networks and experience of working with varied organizations

Education: A post graduate degree in NGO management or any other related subjects. Experience in Organizational Management, finance and NGO development. Experience of having worked with global organizations to establish new organizations would be an added value.

Work Experience: At least 5-10 years of experience working in organizational management, with 1-3 years of work with global or regional coalitions and networks.

Languages: Fluency in English language, both written and spoken. Knowledge of another UN official language would be an asset.
