TB/HIV Care Association would like to invite you to be part of the TB HIV Networking Zone in the Global Village at AIDS 2016 in Durban from 18-22 July 2016.

The TB HIV Networking Zone will feature daily sessions, panel discussions, interactive social media campaigns, and much more.

We invite all civil society organisations, advocates, policy makers and delegates planning to attend AIDS 2016 to **submit a proposal to host a session in our networking zone.**

The **goals of the Networking Zone** are to:

- 1) Increase participants' knowledge of the dual TB-HIV epidemic
- 2) Bridge the gap between HIV and TB communities and organisations by facilitating interaction and sharing best practices for integrated service delivery
- 3) Identify opportunities for communities, key affected populations, researchers, donors and policymakers to collaborate on TB-HIV research policy and programme design.

The deadline for submissions is Wednesday 15 June 2016.

Please note: TB/HIV Care Association CANNOT provide any financial support to organizations wanting to take part in the networking zone. Submitting NGOs must cover all of their own expenses related to attendance at the conference and participation in the networking zone. TB/HIV Care Association cannot facilitate any sponsorships or scholarships for attendees. Organizers must already be registered or planning to attend only the Global Village.

Keep these points in mind when preparing your proposal:

- **Networking Zones** are spaces where groups can engage delegates and the public visiting the Global Village.
- **Sessions should be interactive.**
- **Timing:** Sessions must be 45 minutes or 75 minutes in length (to allow for 15 minute turnover between sessions).
